



LNG – Personal Protective Equipment

\triangle 1.0 Purpose

Δ

To provide direction to workers regarding personal protective equipment (PPE) at the Yukon Energy Corporation Whitehorse Gas generating facility (WG0).

△ 2.0 Minimum mandatory personal protective equipment (PPE)

Note - Accidental contact of LNG with skin or eyes may cause a freezing injury similar to a burn.

- Δ 2.1 The following PPE must be worn at WG0:
 - Safety headwear; Class E, type II;
 - Safety footwear with dielectric rating;
 - Safety eyewear with side shields;
 - Personal gas detector; bumped and calibrated; and
 - Hearing PPE (as req'd).



2.2 Other PPE includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Face shield;
- Long-sleeved shirt or coverall;
- Cuff-less leg covering (trousers or coveralls);
- Clean insulated gloves approved for cryogenic work;
- Clean insulated apron approved for cryogenic work
- Hearing protection (as required);
- Fall arrest/restraint (body harness & lanyard as required);
- Barricades or flagging tape to restrict entry into specific work areas;
- Other required PPE as described in SDS for chemicals in use at WG0.

3.0 Guidelines

- Δ 3.1 All workers are responsible to wear adequate PPE at WG0.
- Δ 3.2 All workers are responsible to inspect their PPE before each use to confirm it is in good condition.
- Δ 3.3 All workers must wear proper PPE while working around the system, especially when making or breaking connections.
 - 2.5 Do not allow cryogenic liquid to splash, spill or leak.
 - 2.6 Protect eyes and cover skin wherever the possibility of contact with liquid, cold equipment or cold gas exists.
 - 2.7 Cuff-less trousers should be worn over the shoes to allow spilled liquid to be shed away from the worker's body.
